

SCHOOL DISTRICT INSTRUCTIONAL ORGANIZATION

The Clinton Community School District offers an education program for grades preschool through grade twelve. The levels of instruction are organized by the following levels:

Four-year olds in the Clinton community have the opportunity to participate in 4-year-old preschool at no cost to the family since the district participates in the statewide preschool program.

Grades kindergarten through five shall attend elementary school.

Grades six through eight shall attend middle school.

Grades nine through twelve shall attend high school. High school students have the opportunities in taking post-secondary classes through the community college and universities.

Each school building will have a principal responsible for the administration and management of the school building, the school building employees and the education program. The principals shall work closely with the superintendent, who shall oversee the administration and management of the school district.
