

INSUFFICIENT CLASSROOM SPACE

Insufficient classroom space exists when conditions adversely affect the implementation of the educational philosophy and program of the Clinton Community School District Board. The Superintendent shall determine insufficient classroom space on a case-by-case basis. Criteria to be used by the Superintendent in determining insufficient classroom space may include, but may not be limited to:

- available personnel
- the grade level
- the educational program
- the instructional method
- the physical space, equipment and materials available
- student-teacher ratios
- facilities either being planned to be closed, planned or under construction
- finances available
- a sharing agreement in force or planned
- a bargaining agreement in force
- board-adopted school District goals and objectives

Ratios shall be maintained, as required by law, for special education students.
