Call to Order: Board President House called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

Presentations:

1. Julie Weisshaar from Energy Association of Iowa Schools shared how our membership is benefiting the school district and the opportunities it is providing for our students.
2. Synergy students, Cammi Bengtson, David Kremer, Kirstyn Henningsen, Michael Griffin, Riley Gravert, Sophia Petersen shared with the board the mural project that they are working on with the community.

New Business:

1. Asbestos Bids: Motion #1093-5-25-21, moved Gettes, seconded by Pelham. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to award the bid to Advanced Environmental in the amount of \$77,100 for asbestos removal in the classroom/hallway tile for the 1919 portion of the CHS building.

2. Classified and Certified – New Hires, Resignations, Retirements: Motion #1094-5-25-21, moved Bengtson, seconded by Reed. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the hiring of Austin Houzenga as Eagle Heights second grade teacher with a salary of \$43,749; Kaelee Stenerson as CMS Strategist II: BD/LD teacher with a salary of \$47,084; Chol Chagai as After School Program Director with a salary of \$4,137.93 (pro-rated); Ramesha Goodall as CMS site facilitator with a salary of \$10.30/hr; Lauren Smith as CMS food service cashier with a salary of \$11.35/hr; Aiden Lubs as CHS summer baseball/Softball groundskeeper with a salary of \$13.06/hr; Kaitlyn Prier as bus monitor with a salary of \$11.36/hr; David Rosales as District Orchestra teacher with a salary of \$46,288 and CHS/CMS Orchestra Director with a salary of \$4,527. Resignations from Nathan Blount as Jefferson head custodian, Susan Keegan as CHS sign language club advisor; Kaitlyn Bussie as Eagle Heights Paraeducator; Amanda Steines as CHS RSVP club advisor; and Thomas McCormick as CHS special assistant to the Activities Director.

3. Cooperative Agreement with St. Ambrose University: Motion #1095-5-25-21, moved Reed, seconded by Sullivan-Pope. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved the field experiences in pre-student teaching, student teaching and other education experiences agreement for the 2021-2022 school year between the St. Ambrose University and the Clinton Community School District.

4. Afterschool Program Contracts for 2021-2022: Motion #1096-5-25-21, moved Gettes, seconded by Green. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved the 1.5% wage increase for the Afterschool Program for 2021-2022.
