**Explore the world with us from 10:00 a.m. to Noon  
on Saturdays this summer!**

- June 10 Take a nature stroll around the **Bickelhaupt Arboretum** and learn about the flora and fauna on the grounds. Trees are our specialty so “Tree Cheers” to you and our family friendly activities at the Arboretum. A surprise craft and treat will be waiting for you on this sunny day! *T-shirts will be distributed at this event and all events thereafter.*
- June 24 Find out what happens to all the trash that you throw away as we tour the **Clinton County Solid Waste Agency**. Learn about the life cycle of a landfill and how recycling does not end at the curb. Closed-toe shoes required.
- July 15 Explore the great outdoors at the **Izaak Walton League**. Experience fun in the outdoors, canoeing, fishing, and a hayride on the prairie and the wetlands. There will also be a demonstration on archery and firearms (*no live ammunition*). Lunch will be served. Note: Wear shoes that fully cover the feet (no flip-flops or sandals).
- July 22 Enjoy a baseball game with the **Clinton LumberKings** at the ballpark, with special recognition of EnviroKids at 6:00 p.m. Check-in starts at 5:30 p.m. (Admission free for EnviroKids only.)
- July 29 Its Worm Time at the **Felix Adler Children's Discovery Center**, and composting is job-one for our red wigglers. Come build a habitat, add some worms, and take it all with you to compost at home and reduce stress on the environment. We'll eat some worms too – gummies, of course!
- Aug 5 Ride on the Blue Heron pontoon boat, pond study, stand-up paddle boards, kayaks, and canoes for families at the **Mississippi River Eco Tourism Center** (Rock Creek Marina). Complete the fun with yummy S'mores. Adults are welcome to accompany children with water activities.
- Aug 19 **The Sawmill Museum** is where local history comes to life! Explore our new exhibits, including the water table, and play like a lumberjack in our 1888 lumber camp. Create a craft to take home, and learn how to play with old-time games. From 10:30 – 11:30 LyondellBasell will be presenting Special Science Based Experiments.
