

# Clinton High School Alumni Hall of Honor

## **Purpose**

The purpose of the Clinton High School Alumni Hall of Honor (HOH) is:

1. To recognize the achievements and accomplishments of Clinton High School Alumni
2. To show current and future students what is possible for graduates of Clinton High School

## **How is one nominated for the Clinton High School Alumni HOH?**

- Nomination forms are available online at the district/high school website, at the district and high school offices
- Nominations are accepted anytime, but the deadline to be considered for the April 2022 recognition will be November 1, 2021.
- A nomination form is filled out and returned to the Clinton Superintendent via the district office by paper or electronically
- The nomination is reviewed by the HOH selection committee in November/December
- The committee selects the recipients based on the nomination/selection criteria
  
- **Criteria for Selection and Eligibility** (Exceptions approved by selection committee, i.e. left for military service during WW II)
  - Alumni from CHS at least 10 years prior
  - A person may be nominated more than once
  - Nominations are considered for 3 years
  - Nominee must possess outstanding moral character
  - HOH recognition may be given posthumously
  - Nominees will have distinguished themselves in one or more of the following areas after high school:
    - Accomplishments in Academic Fields
    - Humanitarian Endeavors
    - Professional Career Accomplishments
    - Public or Community Service
    - Exceptional Contributions to the Clinton School District
    - Distinguished Military Service
    - The Arts

### **How will the voting work?**

- The committee will review the applicants and individually rank them based on the selection criteria

### **Once chosen, how will candidates be honored?**

- The committee will notify the candidate or candidate's family of his/her selection
- The Alumni HOH recipient(s) at the Clinton High School Academic Awards Night in April 2020 as well as at a community reception
- A plaque with a picture of the recipient and a description of his/her accomplishments will be placed in a prominent place in the high school
- The media will be contacted regarding the recipients
