**Call to Order:** Board President House called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.

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**3. SBRC Preschool Funds:** Motion #1097-2-14-22, Borgeson moved, seconded by Green. Motion carried 6-0. The board moved to approve the resolution as part of the district's response to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, the district's administration is authorized to submit a request to the School Budget Review Committee for funding related to FY22 SWVPP increased enrollment in the amount of \$43,362.

**4. Donations:** Motion #1098-2-14-22, Ferguson moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 6-0. The board moved to approve the donation of \$923.28 from Clinton Substance Abuse Council for the Eagle Heights balance of the Charlie Applestein Training and \$11,500 from the Estate of Joan E. Watson for the Jean Hammer Lentz Memorial Music Scholarship.
