1. Change Order #14: Motion #1290-8-8-22, Green moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 6-0. The board moved to approve change order #14 for a deduct in the amount of \$44,878.84 for the CHS Construction/Renovation Project with Tricon Construction.

2. Partnership School: Motion #1291-8-8-22, Pelham moved, seconded by Reed. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the Partnership School Consortium Agreement with Central DeWitt Community School District for the 2022-2023 school year

3. 2022 Revenue Bond Resolution: Motion #1292-8-8-22, Ferguson moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the Resolution Appointing Paying Agent, Bond Registrar, and Transfer Agent, Approving the Paying Agent, Bond Registrar and Transfer Agent Agreement and Authorizing the Execution of the Same.

4. Tax Exemption Certificate Approval: Motion #1293-8-8-22, Borgeson moved, seconded by Reed. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve that the form of Tax Exemption Certificate be placed on file.

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5. Continuing Disclosure Certificate: Motion #1294-8-8-22, Reed moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the form of Continuing Disclosure Certificate be placed on file.

6. Issuance and Securing Resolution: Motion #1295-8-8-22, Ferguson moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the Resolution Authorizing and Providing for the Terms of Issuance and Securing the Payment of \$15,000,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2022, of the Clinton Community School District, State of Iowa, Under the Provisions of Chapters 423E and 423F of the Code of Iowa, and Providing for a Method of Payment of Said Bonds.

7. Renewal of Cooperative Athletic Sharing Agreements: Motion #1296-8-8-22, Pelham moved, seconded by Green. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve renewal of a cooperative athletic sharing agreement for the 2022-2023 seasons with the following schools for activities not provided by their resident school: Prince of Peace: Boys and Girls Bowling, Boys and Girls Tennis, Boys and Girls Swimming and Football; DeWitt Boys and Girls Swimming; Camanche Boys Soccer and Boys and Girls Swimming.

8. Signing/Retention Bonus: Motion #1297-8-8-22, Borgeson moved, seconded by Ferguson. Motion carried 6-1 with Austin dissenting. The board moved to approve the recommendation to increase the signing/retention bonus for CMS/CHS Special Education Paraeducators from \$500 to \$1500 for the 2022-2023 school year.

9. Legislative Priorities 2022-2023: Motion #1298-8-8-22, Green moved, seconded by Reed. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve the legislative action priorities.

10. Appointment of Delegate to 2022 IASB Legislative Session: Motion #1299-8-8-22, Green moved, seconded by Borgeson. Motion carried 7-0. The board moved to approve Ferguson as the Clinton Community School District representative to the IASB Delegate Assembly that will be held on November 16, 2022.
