- A GPA of 2.5 or better
- High School transcript
- 500 word essay on why you are deserving of this scholarship.
- Listing of school and community involvement over the last four years. Include: length of involvement, leadership positions held, awards received, hours/week, purpose of activity/group
- Financial need
- Completed application

Applications are due in the Clinton High School Counselor's office by **Wednesday, April 14th**. Scholarship will be presented to recipient at the Clinton High School Senior Convocation in May. Scholarship will be sent directly to the college attending in the fall.
