

Grace I. and Mary E. Disbrow Scholarship

The Grace I. and Mary E. Disbrow scholarship was established in 2006. This year's recipient will receive a scholarship in the amount of approximately \$2500.

Grace and Mary Disbrow were sisters who were born and raised in Clinton. Grace received a master's degree from the University of Iowa and taught at Lyons Jr. High for 40 years. Mary graduated from Grinnell College and St. Mary's School of Nursing. She also had a degree in medical library science. She served in the Navy for fourteen years and also worked as a medical librarian for various hospitals.

As an applicant you must:

1. Rank in the top half of your graduating class.
2. Complete the application on the reverse side.
3. Write a letter explaining why you should be selected as the recipient.
4. Submit a letter of reference from one of the following: counselor, associate principal, or principal **AND** submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher whose class you've attended.

The Selection Committee will consist of the Superintendent of the Clinton Community School District, Principal of Clinton High School, and the President of the Board of Education. Financial need of the applicant shall be one of the factors considered. If necessary, personal interviews will be held with the Selection Committee and the applicants.
