

Emil E. Johannsen Scholarship

Emil E. Johannsen was a Clinton native that never had a college education. He was a decorated U. S. Army veteran who lived quietly at Clinton's Lafayette Hotel until his death in 1998 at the age of 81. He never lived to where you thought he had any money and was a person that appreciated what you could do with an education and wanted to quietly help people.

Upon his death, Johannsen's estate created five tuition scholarships of \$1000 each for Clinton High School seniors and one \$1000 tuition scholarship for one Prince of Peace Academy senior. First consideration shall be given to seniors desiring to attend Clinton Community College. Students planning to attend elsewhere may also apply.

The scholarships will be based upon need and academic performance and will be paid directly to the educational institution in which the students attend.

The committee to review the applications and select the winners will be: the CHS Principal, Activities Director and Counselors.

Students who believe they qualify for this scholarship must complete the application on the reverse side of this sheet, and on a separate sheet of paper type a paragraph answering each of the following questions:

- What are your educational and career goals?
- To what extent are your parents/guardian willing to help finance your education?
- How are you planning to help support yourself in college?
- Why do you feel you should be considered for this scholarship?
- What special situations or circumstances (if any) should the committee know about in evaluating your application?

Include a transcript and one letter of recommendation with this application.

Return to School Counseling Office on or before Wednesday, April 14, 2021

Recipients will be notified prior to Senior Convocation in May and will be expected to attend Convocation for the presentation of this scholarship.
