

Honors Courses



Clinton High School offers Honors courses to students who are willing to work at a faster pace than the regular education curriculum. These are not to be confused with Advanced Placement classes which enable students to complete college-level studies during high school. However, a lot of colleges do look for students who pursued a demanding high school curriculum. All Honors courses are calculated on a 5-point scale for GPA in which an A = 5, B = 4, C = 3, D = 1. Students enrolled in Honors courses will be required to take the courses' final.

There are many Honors courses available to freshman and sophomores including: Honors English 9 & 10, Honors Biology, Honors Chemistry, Honors Geometry, Honors Algebra 2 and Honors U.S. History. Students are encouraged to be a part of the freshman and sophomore honors program. When making this decision, students should consider their Iowa Assessment scores, attendance, activities, GPA, and grades. There are three Honors courses available to juniors and seniors Honors Algebra 2, Honors Pre-Calculus, and Honors Physics.
