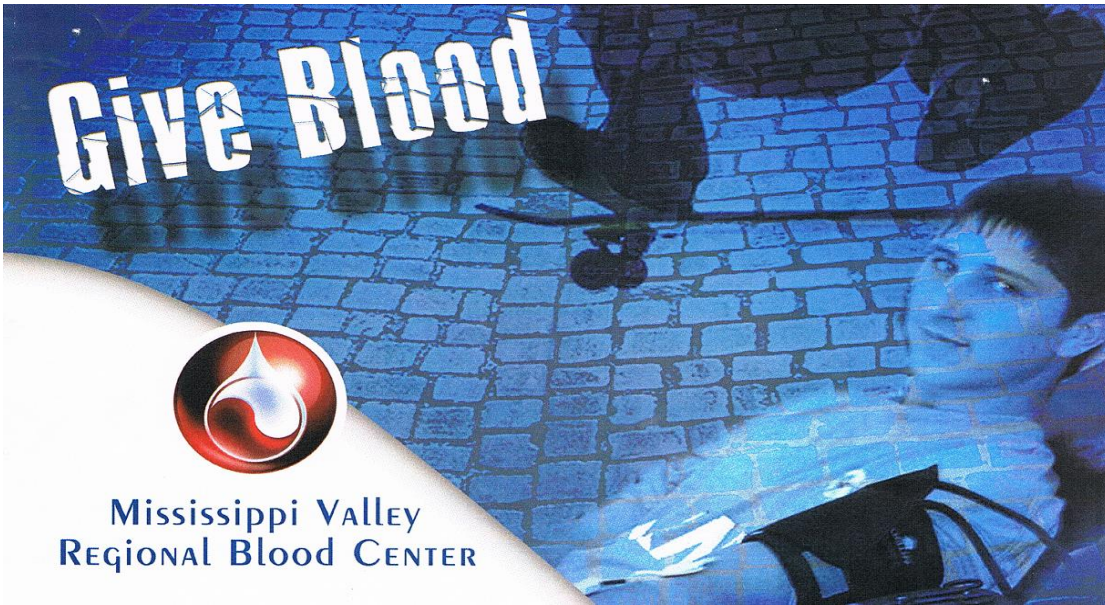


# Jake Kilburg Memorial Scholarship
