

## JEFFERY R. YADDOF AUTO MECHANIC SCHOLARSHIP

In 1987 a young man by the name of Jeffrey Yaddof graduated from Clinton High School. He had a very bright and positive future in the vocational trades. His special interest was auto mechanics.

After enrolling at Scott Community College, he made daily commutes from Clinton to the Scott Community College campus. On one of these trips he was killed in a tragic automobile accident.

Jeff's parents established this scholarship on his behalf to be awarded to a student interested in pursuing a career in auto mechanics or another vocational trade. Jeff's dream lives on through this scholarship.

This \$100 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of Clinton High School who has been enrolled in the auto mechanics course at Clinton High School. The scholarship recipient shall be selected by the senior class administrator, senior class counselor, and designated CHS teacher. Criteria shall include grades, attendance, interest, and ability.

The scholarship will not be paid to the individual scholarship recipient, but will be paid to the auto mechanics school or community college where an auto mechanics course is given, or to any similar institution of the scholarship recipient's choice, in which the scholarship recipient will actually be enrolling in a post-high school course auto mechanics training. In the event the scholarship recipient does not attend a post-high school course of auto mechanics training within one year of graduation from Clinton High School, the scholarship funds will revert back to the fund in which they are kept. If in the opinion of the selection committee, no student in the auto mechanics course deserves the scholarship or there are no students in that course for any reason, the Jeffery Yaddof Scholarship may be given to a graduating senior of Clinton High School who has been enrolled in either the building trades or welding courses.

The scholarship application and transcript must be turned into the School Counseling Office on or before April 23, 2021.

Recipients will be notified prior to Senior Convocation in May and will be expected to attend Convocation for the presentation of this scholarship.
