Application Requirements:

- Two (2) letters of recommendation submitted with application
- A GPA of 2.5 or better
- High School transcript
- 500 word essay on why you are deserving of this award.
- Listing of school and community involvement over the last four years. Include: length of involvement, leadership positions held, awards received, hours/week, purpose of activity/group
- Completed application

Applications are due in the Clinton High School counselor's office by April 23, 2021. The CHS Scholarship Committee will select the recipient of this scholarship. Recipients will be notified prior to Senior Convocation in May and will be expected to attend Convocation for the presentation of this scholarship. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the college attending in the fall.
