The Program:

The Jack & Gerry Voss Memorial Athletic Scholarship goal is to recognize and reward a student athlete who has contributed to his or her team on and off the field. Jack & Gerry were avid sports fans and attended many CHS sporting events watching their children and grandchildren participate.

Eligibility Requirements:

The Jack & Gerry Voss Memorial Athletic Scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior from Clinton High School who:

- ◆ Is or has been a student-athlete and has demonstrated leadership skills both in the classroom and in the sports that they participated in.
- ◆ Have maintained a “B” average in the classroom.
- ◆ Be enrolled or planning to enroll in a 2 or 4 year college full-time.
- ◆ Prefer a recommendation letter from a coach.
- ◆ Applicant should submit a short essay stating why they are deserving of this award.
- ◆ This is to be awarded to an athlete who is NOT receiving a full athletic scholarship.

Scholarship Award Amount:

The “Jack & Gerry Voss Memorial Athletic Scholarship” is an award of \$500.

Recipient Selection:

The “Voss” family will review all applications and select the recipient based on their accomplishments.

Completed applications, letter of recommendation and essay should be turned into the counseling office on or before **April 14, 2022**.

Recipient will be notified prior to Senior Convocation in May and will be expected to attend Convocation.
