

CHARLES ‘CHUCK’ STOLTENBERG SCHOLARSHIP

The Charles Stoltenberg Scholarship of \$3000 will be awarded to a graduating student going into the trade’s field with priority to the welding industry.

Charles William Stoltenberg was born August 23, 1936, in Clinton, Iowa. He graduated from Lyons High School in 1954 and attended Clinton Community College. Charles worked shifts at DuPont for 6 years, then worked 4 years at Glew and Jensen as a mechanic. He went to Hawkeye Chemical Company as a maintenance mechanic and foreman. He left there and went to Chemplex as a high-density maintenance supervisor. He left there in 1971 and joined Union Pipefitter Local 387 in Davenport, IA. He worked for various contractors in the Davenport and Clinton area, retiring in 1996. He owned and operated Stoltenberg Precision Welding until his death.
