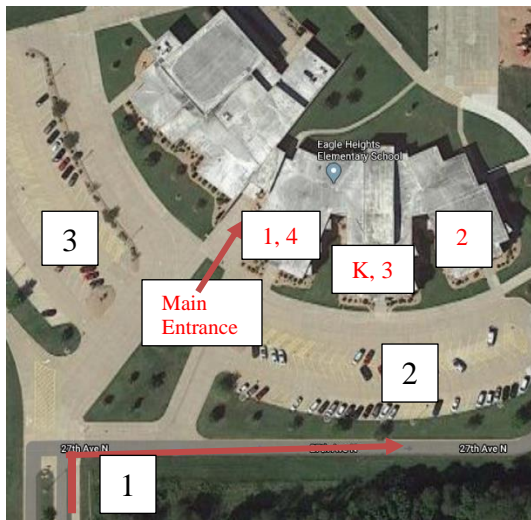
STAFF CHANGES
