The Nathalie Hoop scholarship in the amount of \$2000 per year for four years will be awarded to a graduating Clinton High School student. Nathalie enjoyed interacting with children and was active in the community. Although she never had children of her own, Nathalie had a great love for children. She always wanted to attend college, but was unable to realize this dream. With this scholarship she has made it possible for others to realize theirs! Therefore, this scholarship is for those students who will pursue a degree in education or social sciences; have at least a 2.5 GPA in high school and can demonstrate financial need.

The Scholarship recipient will receive \$2,000 per year for four years, as long as, they are enrolled as a full-time student, major in either education or social science fields and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA in their college studies.

Application Requirements:

- Two (2) letters of recommendation submitted with application
- A GPA of 2.5 or better
- High School transcript
- 500 word essay on why the student is entering their chosen field (must be in education or social sciences) and why they are deserving of this scholarship
- Listing of school and community involvement over the last four years. Include: length of involvement, leadership positions held, awards received, hours/week, purpose of activity/group
- Financial need
- Completed application

Applications are due in the Clinton High School Counselor's office by Monday, March 6, 2023. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the college the recipient will attend in the fall - \$1,000 per semester. Proof of enrollment is required each semester.
