

Terry Sullivan Student Athlete Scholarship

The Program

The Terry Sullivan Student Athlete Scholarship goal is to recognize and reward student athletes who have consistently exhibited selfless dedication and integrity to team and school as well as a strong work ethic throughout their high-school career.

Eligibility Requirements:

The Terry Sullivan Student Athlete Scholarship will be awarded to any graduating senior from Clinton High School who:

- Is or has been a student-athlete and has demonstrated leadership skills both in the classroom and in the sports that they participated in.
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Be enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time course study at an accredited 2 or 4 year college.
- Obtain a recommendation letter from a minimum of one coach, teacher or class advisor.
- Submit a short essay on what the applicant's experience and thoughts on what Character, Leadership, Teamwork, and Work Ethic means to them and how they may have demonstrated these traits.

Preferred Requirement:

- **Participating in collegiate athletics but was not awarded a full tuition athletic scholarship.**

Scholarship Award Amount:

The "Terry Sullivan Student Athlete Scholarship" is an award of \$200.

Recipient Selection

Scholarship recipient is selected by the CHS Administrative Team on the basis of participation in school and athletics, setting an extremely positive example for classmates and teammates. The recipient of this award puts team first and represents CHS in a positive way not only within our school but in the eyes of the community, opponents and officials. Recipient must have demonstrated a tireless work ethic throughout his or her career and a propensity to help elevate others along the way.

Completed application, letter of recommendation and essay should be turned into the counseling office on or before March 3, 2023.
